WOODWARD CANYON ESTATE VINEYARD FACTS

Planted in 1977, Woodward Canyon Estate Vineyard is the westernmost vineyard in Walla Walla Valley AVA roughly 15 miles west of Walla Walla, Washington.

There are 35 vineyard acres planted and several more acres of green belts that support native species such as western juniper, ponderosa pine, western sagebrush, arrowleaf balsamroot, and perennial wildflowers.

The soil composition is Ritzville silt loam over fractured basalt, slope 15-18%, 750-850 ft. elevation.

All grapes are Salmon Safe certified.

Enticing notes of black cherry, spiced oak, and leather come forth on the nose. A full-bodied mouthfeel leads to complex flavors of black fruit, mocha and earth.

Aromas of wet stone, dried herbs, and brambly fruit notes that continues with flavors of dried violets, plum berry and a subtle tomato vine. Sweet, dry tannins create good grip and subtle fruit and savory aromas show varietal typicity.

High toned aromatics of vanilla, spice, and cedar from new oak intermingles with cassis, black cherry, dark fruits, and dried herbs. This deeply concentrated and generous wine has ripe fruit with our classic Walla Walla structure that provides a nice texture and transitions to a well-balanced mouthfeel.
